



British Breed Showcase!

In honor of BreyerFest British Invasion, Breyer has gathered representatives of some of Britain's most treasured native breeds, most of which are now on the UK's Rare Breeds Survival Trust's Watch List (*). Don't miss the opportunity to see these rare breeds up close!

Cleveland Bay*

England's oldest established breed, the Cleveland



Idlehour Savanna

Bay takes its name from the Cleveland district of Yorkshire. Always bay in color, these tall and muscular horses are enjoyed for both driving and riding. The part-bred Cleveland Bay IdleHour Savanna, owned and presented by Maggie Johnston, will be performing with Squire, a Clydesdale owned and presented by Danny Hazel.

Clydesdale*

The quintessential draft horse, the Clydesdale breed originated in Scotland in the 19th century. These towering horses stand upwards of 16hh and can weigh over 1,600 lbs. Originally bred for pulling heavy loads and working on farms, the Clydesdale is presented by Rene Petz of Scotch Bottom Clydesdales.

Dales Pony*

Native to England, the Dales Pony was bred to be a pack pony, carrying heavy loads while navigating rough terrain. Their strength and sure-footedness made them an asset in areas where larger horses would have trouble traveling. The Dales Pony is represented at BreyerFest by Baroque Farms.

Fell Pony*

Closely related to the Dales Pony, the Fell Pony has its roots in northern England where they were used for farm work, packing goods, riding and driving. This

agile and dependable breed is represented by "Littletree Born Supremacy," owned and ridden by Allison Wolff and "Littletree Sirius Black," owned and handled by Heather Kyle of Scafell Pike Fell Ponies.

Gypsy Vanners

The breed known today as the Gypsy Vanner was created by the Gypsies of Great Britain, with the goal of producing a caravan horse resembling a small draft - but with more color and feathering! Highly prized by their Gypsy owners, the first Gypsy Vanners were imported

to the USA in 1996. Gypsy Vanners are well-represented at BreyerFest by Breyer portrait model Taskin, special guest Odd Job Bob and the beautiful Gypsy horses presented by Pegasus Place Gypsies, Bootleg Farm, and T-N-T Gypsy Horses!

Hackney Horses & Ponies*

Hailing from Norfolk, England, the high-stepping Hackney Horse and Pony were bred for speed and style! According to the American Hackney Horse Society, these steeds were the "ultimate driving machine of the 1880's both in America and Britain." These flashy horses and ponies are still bringing their

glamour to carriage driving today! Breyer portrait model Heartland High Tech is a fine example of a Hackney Pony, and other beautiful representatives of the Hackney breed are presented by members of the American Hackney Horse Society.

Welsh Cob

The Welsh Cob originated in Wales, UK, where they flourished despite adverse conditions and became a favored form of transportation! These robust equines have a kind nature, and are well-suited for both driving and riding. The Welsh Cob is presented by Kelly Gage and Team EnGaged.

Mariah's Boon - 2012 Celebration Horse

An American Drum Horse stallion who was ill for months with "hardware disease" hasn't looked back since his recovery and is now immortalized as a Breyer model horse.

Mariah's Boon was a patient at the University of Florida's Large Animal Hospital between 2008 and 2009, when he received two surgeries and numerous checkups for an abdominal abscess caused by a small wire that had penetrated his stomach.

American Drum Horses are a relatively new breed made up of a combination of Shire, Clydesdale, and Gypsy Horses, where none of the three breeds exceed 87% (7/8) of the total make-up, and the percentage of Gypsy Horse blood does not fall below 12.5% (1/8). The inspiration for the American Drum Horse is the working horses still found carrying riders and heavy kettledrums in the Queen of England's cavalry.

After his health problems resolved, he's been busy in the show ring, winning such accolades as Grand Champion Stallion at the Florida State Fair for two years in a row and receiving Grand Champion Drum, Grand Champion Performance Drum and Grand Champion High Point Drum from the Feathered Horse Classic in Georgia.

Although many a horse owner might covet being selected as the Celebration Breyer Horse, for Moon - although she says she is honored by the designation - the real prize is Boon's life, which she credits UF's large animal veterinarians and other staff for saving.

After a show, Moon noticed Boon had a fever. Her veterinarian recommended a trip to the UF Large Animal Hospital. UF veterinarians

Chris Sanchez and Laura Javsicas found a basketball-sized abscess in Boon's abdomen. He also had an infection of the sac surrounding his heart. Because of the location of the abscess and involvement of the heart, veterinarians suspected that Boon ate something that penetrated the wall of his stomach and into his chest - they just couldn't find the culprit.

Boon improved initially, but the abscess returned. Boon received a second surgery at UF, during which Dr Ali Morton created a portal from the abscess to Boon's skin. This allowed improved drainage of the abscess after surgery. Eventually, the hole shrank to the size of a straw. Then one day during a cleaning, Moon saw something dark in the

catheter. She pulled out a piece of metal.

A few days later, more metal came out. The culprits were found and the abscess continued to shrink in size. Within a year, it was the size of a grape and Boon looked like he had never been sick.

"I still carry those pieces of metal around in my truck," Moon said. "It was a miracle. I am so thankful the UF veterinarians never gave up. They came across an obstacle, put their heads together and came up with a new plan. There was nothing in the books they could follow for what Boon had."


