



# **Advanced Pastelling**

SKILL LEVEL: ADVANCED

Take your pastelling skills to the next level! Long-time BreyerFest instructor Laura Thomson hosts this advanced workshop, but her intro video from 2020 will also be available to re-watch this summer during BreyerFest weekend. Pastels are a great way to layer soft, realistic colors on your model horse and add shading and detail. Laura will demonstrate the techniques for using these chalks including how to make them stay on when you're through, as well as taking things to the next level for our more advanced artists.

## **Battle'corns**

#### SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED

With this video workshop learn how to make your Breyer Unicorn into a Battle'corn! Follow along as instructor Laura Rock-Smith shows you the steps she uses to turn any Breyer Unicorn into a battle ready steed. During this video workshop you will learn how to make patterns, apply epoxy, create armor and then add designs to decorate your armor. Plus, she will show you the basics of saddle and bridle designing so your own unicorn will be a battle ready battle'corn!

## **Bitless Bridle**

In this workshop, instructor LeeAnn Masters will be making a bitless bridle for your favorite model horse. The bridle is easy to make and can be made with any color of lace to match your favorite horse. It is also easy to adjust and will fit a variety of models and easy enough to make so that you can make one for every member of the herd.

# **Braided Ribbon Browbands**

#### SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER TO INTERMEDIATE

Give a touch of color to your model bridles with a braided ribbon browband. This style can be seen in the real horse world on ponies, draft horses, and race horse bridles. With the addition of ribbon rosettes they are part of the traditional Spanish show halter. In this workshop, instructor Marcella Peyre-Ferry will demonstrate how to braid the ribbon over a browband to create the two-color pattern. Once you have mastered that skill, she will also cover creating a ribbon rosette to add to your Spanish halter. Workshop covers browbands only. It does not cover halter or bridle making.

## **Canvas Tote Creations**

#### SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER - ADVANCED

Jane Tilton is back with her fun tote bag workshop! This popular workshop will guide you through the steps in painting and customizing your very own tote bag! Learn how to transfer your design onto your tote and follow along as Jane shares her steps on mixing and blending acrylic paints. Learn how to put expression in your horse's eye and get ideas on embellishing your tote.

SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Join Tina Dils to get a jump start on your holidays with our Christmas in July workshop! Learn how to transform your favorite Breyer Stablemates® models into festive holiday ornaments.

# Defying Gravity – Dynamic Manes and Tails!

SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED

Have you ever wanted to know how to do that gravity defying hair you see on some customs? Would you like your locks lifted and flowing with the movement of your horse? Rayvin Maddock will show you how, from building the armature and planning to techniques on how to get that flowy look and break free of the slump of gravity! Rayvin is known for her dynamic sculptures and particularly her flowing, wild and free hair. Join her as she shares her process, tips and tricks so you can create the hair dos of your dreams!

# **Draft Horse Breastcollars**SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

This decorative breastcollar showcases the artistry of Celtic-inspired tack. This beautiful tack is built for function and showcases a rider's rank. In this tutorial, hobbyist Dani Youdris will walk participants through the process of how to assemble one of the many different styles of Celtic-inspired breastcollars. The workshop will include an instruction sheet for you to print out. The breastcollar in this tutorial is sized to fit a larger Traditional (1:9) scale horse such as Othello or Shannondell. This pattern can be shortened and adjusted to fit other models as well.

# Dream Horse Kit Customizing SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Join instructor Kristin Albert as she guides participants in the creation of their own custom classic scale horse using the Dream Horse Customizing kit. Engage the right hemisphere of your brain as we focus on paint blending, and various techniques and ideas to hand-apply paint using paintbrushes, toothbrushes, and makeup sponges. Indulge your creative side as we fashion a mohair mane and tail on our very own custom horse. This is a workshop designed for crafters to engage their creative spirit and unwind their mind by following through the steps described in this fun and relaxing craft kit! Spend some time "in the moment" creating your very own custom model horse!

# **Horse Anatomy**

## SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED

BreyerFest favorite Morgen Kilbourn is offering a new twist on her sculpting process by diving into horse anatomy! In this workshop, participants will study important front end connection, pivot points, and angles so your model's bending and twisting looks realistic. These tips are great whether you're customizing an existing model or creating a unique one of your own! Participants will also learn how to measure and visualize armatures for realistic breed sculpture. Much of the focus of this workshop will be on the neck, shoulders, and legs of the horse. This workshop is ideal for someone with some previous sculpting experience.

Ever wanted to get into customizing and change the look of your Breyer model horse? One method is sculpting a new, unique mane and tail on your model. Join Laura to learn the techniques used for achieving this fun, exciting customizing art form.

# Introduction to Collecting and Showing Model Horses

#### SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Liz Isham Cory's hands-on showing tutorial will take your model collection to a whole new level! Learn from this seasoned shower how to move your herd from the bedroom floor to the show ring. Find out how to spot a winner in your collection! Learn how to assign breeds, learn about different showing classes, and learn the ins and outs of this fun hobby!

# Introduction to Customizing SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

Ever wanted to try your hand at customizing but didn't know where to start? Let Mindy Young get you started! Participants following this tutorial will learn how to mix and use two-part sculpting epoxy as well as how to reshape the manes, tails, and feathers on their Stablemates. This fun workshop will open a whole new world of model horses for you!

# Magic Marble Ponies SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER

BreyerFest veteran workshop instructor Kristin Albert is mixing things up – literally! Learn how to paint marbleized decorator custom horses. Kristin will demonstrate the technique for painting with Easy Marble Paints.

Thanks to the magic of chemistry, and the knowledge that oil and water don't mix, we can use this special paint and water to help create swirly decorator model horses.

# Masque of a Different Color SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED

This "Masque of a Different Color" has been designed specifically to fit the 2021 Breyer Celebration Horse, "Danash's Northern Tempest" (Dani) and is hosted by BreyerFest favorite, Didi Hornberger. Didi will walk participants through making the base shape of the mask and then allow participants to decorate it in any manner you wish, using paint, sequins, rhinestones, gold and silver braid, seed beads, tiny feathers, miniature bells, tiny tassels, glitter glue, fabrics, or anything else you can think up, in any colors you wish.

# Minis Performance – Trail Riding SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER TO ADVANCED

Join Kim and Kathi in learning about trail riding and natural trail events. Participants will build a Stablemates® scale outdoor scene complete with grass, shrubs, flowers, trees and natural trail obstacles. Participants will also learn about different natural trail competitions such as endurance riding, Extreme Cowboy Trail, and competitive trail riding, and learn techniques to build their own dioramas for play or show!

These tricks and techniques are simple and stunning!

# Photo Showing Model Horses SKILL LEVEL: BEGINNER TO ADVANCED

Did you know that you can show your horses anywhere, anytime, through photo showing? Liz Isham Cory's workshop will give you valuable hints and tips on choosing your show string and showing them to their best advantage.

# Pinto and Appaloosas Painting 101 SKILL SET: BEGINNER TO ADVANCED

Learn how to use a variety of different art supplies to make your very own customized Breyer Pinto or Appaloosa model horse! Join Karen Zorn and explore how to use acrylics, pastel pigment powders, and colored pencils to create various types of pinto and appaloosa patterns. Use of the airbrush to create a base color will be demonstrated, and then it's on to explore detailed work by hand with several different techniques.

# Repairing Horses

One of the worst sounds for a Breyer collector to hear is the snap of a leg or break of an ear because of a fall or mishap. When a Breyer gets damaged it can be very upsetting. 

## **Board and Bristol**

#### SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE TO ADVANCED

Does your favorite room need that special, horsey finishing touch? Join Jamie Rott on Zoom as she guides you through the process of taking a plain board and making it into a unique BreyerFest souvenir!
